

GLENCORRIB PIONEER CENTRE

The Glencorrib Pioneer Centre was formed on Saturday 20th October 1928. This year as we celebrate its 80th Anniversary our objective as it was in 1928 is provide our members with an opportunity of living the faith in a most positive manner in a world where alcohol and drug abuse is a major problem world-wide. The impact of such abuse in our society is very clear and displays itself in three ways: upon the individual, the family and society in general. Abstinence from alcohol strengthens young people and enhances their freedom to realise their potential in study, in sport and in work. An important objective of our own centre in Glencorrib has always been the education of our youth in the abstinence of alcohol and drugs and we continue this by visiting the local national schools in Glencorrib, Kilroe and Shrule and promoting the objectives of the Association. How many families have been destroyed by alcohol abuse is anyone's guess but surely we can learn from these tragic lessons and hopefully build a better future for the next generation.

This year we celebrate the commitment and dedication that our officers and members gave to the centre down through the years. On this 80th anniversary, we remember and thank all those officers and members who served in so many capacities.

Our Pioneer Centre is affiliated to the Ballinrobe Region and we have been involved in every activity within the region. These include: essay competitions, table quizzes. Réadóiri competitions - music, song, dance, recitation, novelty act.

In 1999 the Novelty act starring Eileen McCarthy. Margaret Hynes, John Petty and Paddy Fitzgerald won the Regional Semi Final, Connacht Final and went on to win the All-Ireland Final, which was hosted by Connacht that year and held in Gortnor Abbey, Crossmolina.

In 2001 we applied for Gradam Na Réadóiri, which is a merit award for Pioneer Centres. There are nine areas of excellence to he accessed before the Gradam award is recommended. The nine areas include the following: membership and recruitment, spiritual and liturgical activity, participation in regional and diocesan councils, sale and promotion of pioneer magazine and other pioneer publications, support for national P.T.A.A. fundraising, pastoral support of victims of alcohol and drug abuse, involvement of pioneers in local community.

In 2001 we competed for Gradam Na Réadóiri Award for the first time and in March 2002, we were awarded our first Gradam. Nine representatives of the centre travelled to Dublin to the St. Francis Xavier Church where the P.T.A.A. was founded in 1898. A special embroidered pennant and certificate of achievement was presented to the successful applications, which we have received seven years in a row.

In October 2003 we celebrated the 75th anniversary of our centre. The evening started with Mass in Glencorrib church celebrated by Fr. John Creaven, and afterwards Garda Brick from Headford gave a talk to young people from Glencorrib. Kilroe and Shrule schools who were becoming juvenile pioneer members. He spoke to them about [he abuse of alcohol among the youth. Gold, silver and juvenile pins were then presented, followed by a cup of tea and refreshments in the community centre.

Tonight as we celebrate our 80th Anniversary, we look back with pride over the last 80 years. We are a very small centre but we are right up there with the biggest and the best.










