

> **Sunday next, 24th November** Moyne Cemetery @ 3pm Shrule Cemetery @ 4pm.


If the weather is not suitable, cemetery prayers will be said in Glencorrib and Shrule Church.


## The Glencorrib Kilroe CFR Group are delighted to announce that we are now live!

#### What does a Community First Responder group do?

Community First Responders (CFR) are volunteers who are trained to attend certain types of emergency calls in the area where they live or work. Their aim is to reach a potential life threatening emergency in the first vital minutes before the ambulance crew arrives. Their role is to help stabilise the patient and provide the appropriate care including CPR & defibrillation, until the more highly skilled ambulance crew arrives on scene to take over the treatment.



#### How does this work?

Upon receipt of a 999/112 call Community First Responders are dispatched simultaneously with the National Ambulance Service. First Responders are only dispatched to Chest Pain, Breathing difficulty, Choking, Stroke and Cardiac related calls within a three mile (5km) radius of their Communities. Because the people "on call" live or work in their area, they can respond in minutes and provide emergency measures and reassurance until the Ambulance Service arrives



### Would your child(ren) be interested in becoming an altar server?

Pupils from third class upward are welcome to become altar servers - no experience necessary!

It is a long tradition in families that children become altar servers, just as their parents before them. Altar servers have a long history in the church and in celebration of various liturgies, especially on weekends, funerals & weddings. Apart from enhancing the way liturgy is celebrated, becoming an altar server allows a child to grow in confidence and selfesteem by working and carrying out various activities in public, along with learning collaboration, teamwork, cooperation, and communication skills that are the basic building blocks of community.

The aim, depending on numbers, will be to form teams that will be put into a rota. It would be hoped that each team would have 5 pupils from various classes, allowing the students to learn from each other. While this will be the guide in forming teams, every effort will be made to accommodate pupils and parents/quardians.

Finally, in line with diocesan child safeguarding policy, you will need to complete Application Form SG-04, This along with an information leaflet 'Information & Guidance for Children/Parents' will be provided.
